216 **Gewurztraminer ,Bebenheim, Trapet, 2016,** £37.95
Made from the 'spicy grape` ,Gewurztraminer. This gold medal winner is perfect with duck and game birds. An off-dry varietal with lovely freshness .

219 **Jean Baptiste Adam, Pinot Blanc Reserve, 2014** £32.00
Delicious , light, fruity and fresh, less perfumed and aromatic than most Alsace varietals

Southern France, Rhone and Loire

221 **Condrieu, Laurant Betton, 2012** £58.00
Fantastic example of the Viognier grape, full of peach and apricot flavours, one of the most delicious white wines we have tasted !

224 **Sancerre, Domaine Chaumeau-Balland , 2017,** £37.95
Classic, bone dry , full of fruit with a hint of gooseberries and blackcurrant leaf. A really lovely Sauvignon Blanc with a cool lingering finish.

225 **Pouilly_ Fume, Pierre Marchand, 2017,** £37.00
This wine displays a natural richness with notes of gooseberry, grapefruit and flint with a very pleasant mineral finish

227 **Riesling Kabinett, Dr H Thanisch, Mosel ,Germany 2016** £38.95
