

## France- Burgundy

- 111 **Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Domaine Fichet, 2015** **£35.95**  
*The wine has striking redcurrant aromas, fresh and lively on the palate with good structured tannins and a broad round finish.*
- 112 **Nuits -St-Georges, Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Forey, 2015** **£78.95**  
*Considered by many as one of the very top producers .Exceptional terroir allied to well- handled, sensitive winemaking.Hints of red stone fruits and spices with a supple finish.*
- 113 **Mercurey, Les Montots,Domaine A. ET P. De Villaine,2013**  
*Pale crimson, with spice and savoury but fruit to the fore .Firm and full of energy, the tannins already rounded.* **£65.95**

## France-Rhone

- 130 **Crozes- Hermitage, Domaine Belle,Les Pierrelles, 2015** **£39.95**  
*A rejuvenated company!Excellent Syrah,rich balance of black fruit, pepper and leather. Not too heavy for a Rhone wine.*
- 131 **Vacqueyras, Le Plan des Moines, La Cape, 2014** **£45.95**  
*located in the Southern Rhone Valley the old vines of Grenache and Syrah give richness and spice. Discovered and cultivated by the monks centuries ago these vineyards are maintained in much the same way.*
- 132 **Gigondas , La Gille, Perrin &Fils, 2013** **£49.95**  
*Spicy, chocolate blackberries and pepper, full-bodied and smooth, great blend of Grenache and syrah. From the highly respected Perrin family renowned for their Chateauneuf du Pape. We think this is every bit as good!*
