- 139 **Il Principe, Nero d`Avola, Cantine Rallo, Sicily, 2015** £30.95
100 % Nero d`Avola grapes, cherries, blackcurrant and ripe red fruit, round and persistent. Goes well with pork and tomato based sauces.
- 140 **Chianti Classico, Terre di Prenzano, Vignamaggio, 2015** £35.95
From the heart of the Chianti district; full bodied with fruity finish. Best we have tasted.
- 142 **Amarone della Valpolicella, Cecilia Beretta , 2011,** £59.95
Very robust powerful wine from Veneto in northern Italy. Rich, strong and complex wine made from dried grapes. Perfect with strong cheese and red meats .
- 143 **Il Pino di Biserno, P&L Antinori ,Tuscany, 2013,** £78.95
This is Cabernet Franc territory making up 40% of the blend with Merlot, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Sauvignon. Gorgeous nose of dark plums, blueberries and smoky and savoury notes leading to a rich mouthful of succulent silky fruit.

Spain and Portugal

- 145 **Vina Ardanza Rioja Reserva ' La Rioja Alta', Spain 2008** £59.95
this wine has won a gold medal for this vintage and no wonder! medium bodied
Velvety is the best way to describe it.
- 148 **Duas Quintas, Ramos Pinto, Douro, 2015** £33.95
*Amazing red from the Douro Valley. Casa Ramos being a pioneer in the region .Tastes like Port with the spirit removed.
Really ripe and fruity a good vintage!*

AUSTRALIA

- 150 **The Musician, Majella, Connawarra, Shiraz -Cabernet Sauvignon, 2015**

Produced by a very well renowned winery. This is a big, fruity dangerously easy drinking wine, ripe fruits wrapped in silk!
- 151 **Sangiovese, Mad Dog,Barossa Valley, 2012** £45.00
Sangiovese being the great grape of Tuscany is now very at home in the Barossa Valley.Aromas of peppery spice and stewed cherry fruit rise from the glass, quite seductive. Style wise ,this is somewhere between Crianza Rioja and Chianti Classico.
