**157 Pinot Noir, Zephyr, Malborough, 2014** **£36.95**  
*A lovely medium bodied Pinot, fresh redcurrant fruit with complexity. Great with quail and duck.*

**158 Mount Edward Pinot Noir ,Central Otago, 2015,** **£55.00**  
*Nestled along the Kawarau river providing shelter from the heat to give a long ripening period This summer produced a superbly balanced wine displaying concentrated berry fruits and spice . More fruit in this than a whole case of red burgundy.*

## Lebanon

**159 Chateau Musar , Serge Hochar 2010** **£49.00**  
*Remarkable wine from the war-torn Bekka Valley. Absolutely masses of Big rich flavours. Cabernet / Cinsault blend.*

## South Africa

**161 Mr P, Pinot Noir, Iona, Elgin, 2016** **£32.95**  
*Dark cherry ,strawberry and violet notes with velvety tannins and silky smooth texture , easy drinking.*

**163 Mary le Bow, The Drift, Robertson, 2011** **£46.95**  
*A full bodied wine, a blend cabernet,shiraz and petit verdot. Beautiful complex nose of blackcurrant and mulberry fruits .Pure elegance and sophistication.*

**164 Pinotage , Southern Right, Hemel-En Aarde Valley ,2016** **£48**  
*Elegance and freshness with flavours of cherries and blackcurrant , with subtleties of dried herbs and spice lending complexity . Serious wine making skills, restrained but full-bodied wine. Southern Right makes a contribution to the conservation of the Southern Right whales that that visit nearby Hermanus from May to December with every bottle sold.*

**165 Iona Pinot Noir, Elgin, 2014,** **£49**  
*Raspberry and red cherry fruit on the nose and palate. From the cooler climate region of Elgin that seems to suit the Pinot Noir grape. Lots of finesse and elegance, more old world in style.*
