WHITES

Egy Kis , Dry Furmint, Barta winery, Tokaji ,Hungary, 2017 , £38.95
From the village of Mad, organically farmed, gorgeous core of orchard fruit purity and spice to this food friendly wine. Its got lovely pinot gris characters with a bone dry mineral backbone and length.

Tino, Vermentino di Sardegna,DOC,Mora&Memo,Italy,2017 £45.95
Vermentino from Sardinia, Straw colour with green tints. Intense and persitent with scents of flowers, rosemary and thyme.

Bosstok Chenin Blanc,Rhebokskloof, Paarl, South Africa,2018
£35.95

Proper Chenin...complex, food friendly,yet insanely drinkable, quince, tropical fruits and honey on the nose, a drier than norm palate, juicy and clean with a citrus tang.

ROSE

Sancerre, Domaine Jean Paul Picard, Loire, France, 2016 £45.95
Made from Pinot Noir, quite intense exotic fruits. In the mouth:dry ,fruity and supple. A serious rose!

REDS

Moulin A Vent, Coeur de Terroirs, Domaine Labruyere, France 2014

A most impressive estate that majors on the most impressive cru in Beaujolais, gamay grape tends to be more like traditional Burgundy, dark fruit with polished textues on the palate.

Spatburgunder, Schloss Schonborn, Rheinhessen, Germany, 2013
£45.95

Pinot Noir, also known as Spatburgunder, has been delivering some impressive reds from the Rheinhessen and Baden.This lovely example from one of the oldest wineries in the region ,has fresh berry and blueberry notes with delicate spice, weight and fine acidity on the palate and length.

Nau, Cannonau di Sardegna,DOC,Mora&Memo,Sardinia, Italy,2016,

100% Cannonau grape, intense ruby red colour with violet reflections, aromas of red berry, coffee and spice.

Vagabond Grenache,Blewitt Springs,Mclaren Vale, Thistledown,
South Australia,2016 £65.95

Beautifully balanced,violet scented with red fruits, savoury oak and a warm silky finish.
